# "Ishi and His Remarkable Legacy" by

# Richard Burrill

On Saturday, July 15, 2006 Author Richard Burrill shared his latest research finding on Ishi to an audience of Sacramento Archeological Society members and general public at the Yolo County Library: Arthur F. Turner Branch in West Sacramento.

Richard shared three griping stories about Ishi. First, he shed light on the "not-so-good", Hi Good and his demise. Richard has been able to unravel facts about his death. Second, the identity of "Damabus", the child who Ishi's talked with in the San Francisco park was finally identify by Richard's persistence. Lastly, Richard talked about participants in "Ishi's Play Day" in 1914 and identified "who she was". It didn't matter how much the audience knew about Ishi. Richard added new information to a point in history.
